Code of conduct for Students

Do:

- e) Read notices/circulars displayed on the college notice board and comply with the directions contained in it.
- f) Pay all kinds of fees as stipulated by the college in time.
- g) Adhere to the vehicle rules, vehicle speed limit within the campus and park the vehicles in the allotted place.
- h) Maintain the decorum and behave well while attending college functions.
- i) Give respect to the National Flag / Anthem / Prayer.
- j) Use the Wet/Dry waste dustbin facility to keep the classroom and the campus clean.
- k) Maintain the beauty, serenity and greenery of the campus.
- 1) Preserve the infrastructure of the college.
- m) Be careful and responsible while posting their views about the institute on social media.

- c) Use mobile phones within the college premises unless permitted

- e) Paste wall posters, writing on walls and roads.
- f) Give false information to the college.
- g) Forge, alter or misuse any document or record issued by the college.
- h) Store, possess or use real or replica firearms or other weapons, explosives (including fireworks), ammunition, or toxic or otherwise dangerous materials in the campus.
- i) Use, possess or distribute liquor and illegal drugs.

Identity card for Students
