Preamble: The Academic Council of SDMCET approved the following in 24<sup>th</sup> AC meeting held on 8.09.2021 and 25<sup>th</sup> AC meeting held on 29.12.2021.

- 1. The scheme of study and examination from the academic year 2021-22 (under NEP 2020) which now under execution.
- 2. The amendments (pertaining to NEP 20202 implementation) of regulations governing academic autonomy from the Academic year 2021-22.

The approved scheme, syllabi and regulations are released, distributed to the students and published on the College website, in the beginning of the semester (December 2021) for the academic year 2021-22.

The VTU issued Guidelines and regulations for Autonomous Institutions on 3.05.2022 under the title "Regulations governing B.E. / B.Tech programs under CBCS" and also issued "Guidelines and norms for implementation of academic autonomy framed under section 20(w) of VTU act 1994" on 17.05.2022 through email from academic year 2021-22 and informed the institutions to refer while preparing the regulations. The college went through the guidelines issued by VTU. The regulations framed at SDMCET are almost in line with the guidelines. At SDMCET, AC approved Regulations book is already distributed to the students for the academic year 2021-22, it is felt that the changes, if any, shall be considered during the next revision. Any changes in teaching and evaluation call for the modification of ERP at coding level.

However, the Chairman, Academic Council, SDMCET desired to convene the AC meeting for the kind consent of Honourable AC members to consider few suggestions given by VTU and also reassert few clauses (rules) as detailed in the Agenda below.

#### Proposed Addition to the existing rule:

The students who have been detained due to want of attendance and CIE marks are required to reregister in Supplementary semester. The students who have satisfied CIE and Attendance requirements for the course/s and obtained F grade in SEE are permitted to appear directly in ensuing examination/s as backlog paper/s. The students need not re-register for such course/s in the supplementary/ fast track semester.

**Minutes:** There is no change in **R4.1.6** of SDMCET Regulations Governing Academic Autonomy effective from 2021-22, in respect of Supplementary Semester and the addition mentioned above to the existing rule is approved and shall be applicable from the current even semester of the academic year 2021-22.

Agenda 1: Approval sought for the revised academic calendar and conduct of examination for lateral entry students as one time measure:

#### Preamble:

Due to delay in admission process, diploma students just have started taking admission to 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester as per the provision by VTU as lateral entry in respective branches and the admission process would be completed by the end of 1<sup>st</sup> week of Jan 2022. Nearly 150 students are expected to take admission across the branches in our college.

The classes for 3<sup>rd</sup> semester students started from 1.10.2021 and about 70-75% of the syllabus is completed over the past three months. The lateral entry students are getting only one month time as per the existing academic calendar and will learn about 25 to 30% contents in the syllabus.

Arranging extra classes for the contents covered in three months to teach in the available one month time along with the regular time table is very difficult and the students would be highly stressed. This would affect their performance and reduce their confidence besides lack of meaningful learning. In view of the above, it is proposed to adopt the following as one time provision.

The lateral entry students will attend the classes along with the regular students till the last working day as per the existing academic calendar. In addition special time table will be framed to conduct classes for five more weeks(from 1<sup>st</sup> Feb to 5<sup>th</sup> March 2022) to cover the entire syllabus. This will result in better learning because of the extension in the term days.

There is a provision for the regular students to appear for makeup examination who do not succeed in the main exam and the makeup exam will be conducted in the second week of March 2022 for such students.

It is proposed to conduct Semester End Examination for lateral entry students along with students appearing for makeup examination which ensure that lateral entry students will be in the main stream. For lateral entry students, the makeup examination will be treated as first attempt without grade reduction.

Hence, seeking approval for extension of term and conduct of SEE (Semester End Examination) for lateral entry (Diploma) students along with the regular students taking make up examination in the month of March 2022 as one time measure.

- 1) Approved for extension of term and conduct of SEE (Semester End Examination) for lateral entry (Diploma) students along with the regular students taking make up examination in the month of March 2022 as one time measure.
- 2) Approved the revised Academic Calendar.

Correction of award of class in the degree certificate of MBA student P. Deepak Kumar bearing USN: 2SD17MBA26 passed out during the academic year 2018-19.

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As per the Autonomy governance norms of SDMCET, for UG and programs, the list graduating students will be approved by Academic Council and recommended to Governing Council for award of degree. In the case of any issue related to award of class and degree shall be brought before Academic Council for ratification. In this back ground there is an error in marking the grade and award of class of a MBA student. It is appealed to Academic Council for consideration and for further course of action. The issue is as detailed under:

The performance of the PG students in the examination will be one grade less than the grade obtained, if they get grade "S", "A" or "B". But there is no grade reduction for the students who obtain "C" grade. For example, if a student obtains "A" grade in the makeup examination, then one grade will be reduced and grade "B" will be awarded. If a student obtains "C" grade in the makeup examination, as this grade is the minimum grade for passing the course for PG programs, there will not be any grade reduction and will be awarded as grade "C" only (refer attachment).

As applied to the above student, he appeared for the makeup examination and obtained "C"

Academic Council considered the correction of error in view of the student's actual performance not being reflected in degree certificate. with a note to the college to avoid such errors in future. Further, suggested to appeal to VTU for kind consideration keeping in view the natural justice.

grade and the same grade "C" is to be retained. But, due to an error in the ERP software, the C grade is reduced to D grade (which is applicable to UG programs as the grades are from "S" to "E") and accordingly the CGPA is calculated. The CGPA of the student with "C" grade will be 7.86 and class award will be First Class with Distinction (refer attachment). Due to the error happened in ERP software, the CGPA is computed as 7.70 and class award is First Class( refer attachment). In the above backdrop, it is placed before Academic Council through circulation to consider and permit for the correction of the error and also permit to appeal to the VTU authorities for favourable consideration.




