Description:

Various students' centric methods such as Experiential Learning, Participative Learning, and Problem Solving Methodologies are used in course plan on need base; relevant to the particular course for enhancing learning experience.

Provisions for various best practices in curriculum are listed below:

- 1. Course Teachers' Assessment (CTA): Structural provision in every course for 10 marks, a flexibility given to course teachers to frame the assessment tool such as quizzes, programming based assignments and problem solving based assignments.
- 2. Course Plan: Publishing course plan on the 1st day of the semester that indicates total coverage and assessment plan to indicate critical thinking levels of the assignments and action plan based on attainment of outcomes observed in general.
- 3. Showing answer scripts of Semester End Examination (SEE) to students: After evaluation of all answer scripts, they are shown to students to know any discrepancy in evaluation before the results are announced officially. This has reduced the number of applications for revaluation allowing only genuine cases to proceed as per the process.
