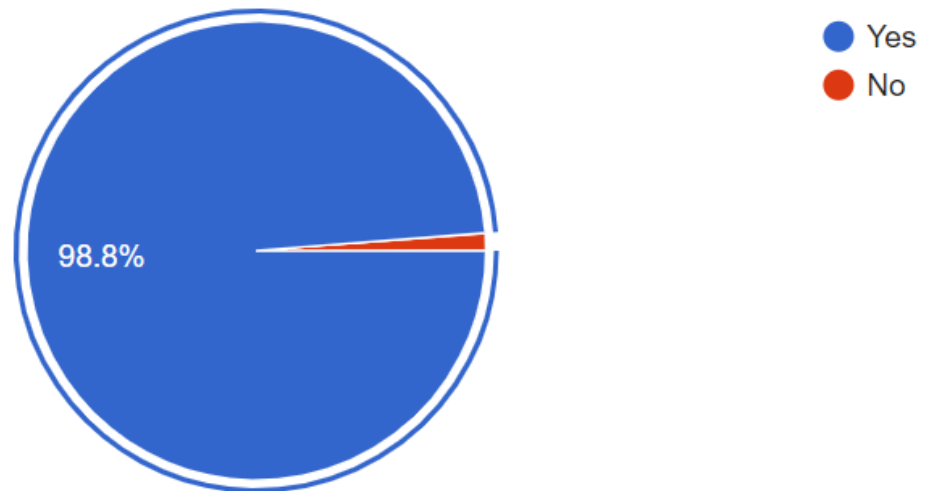

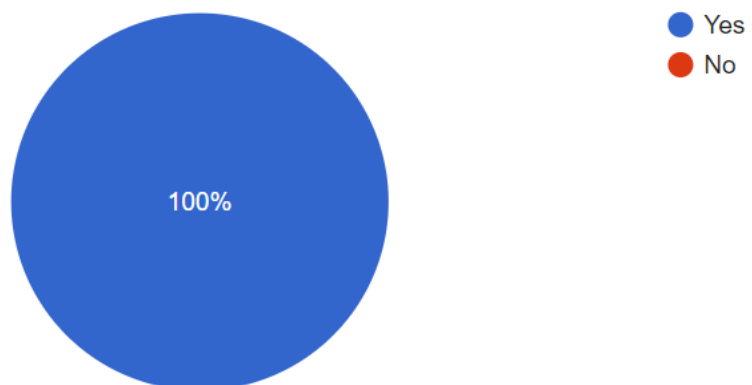

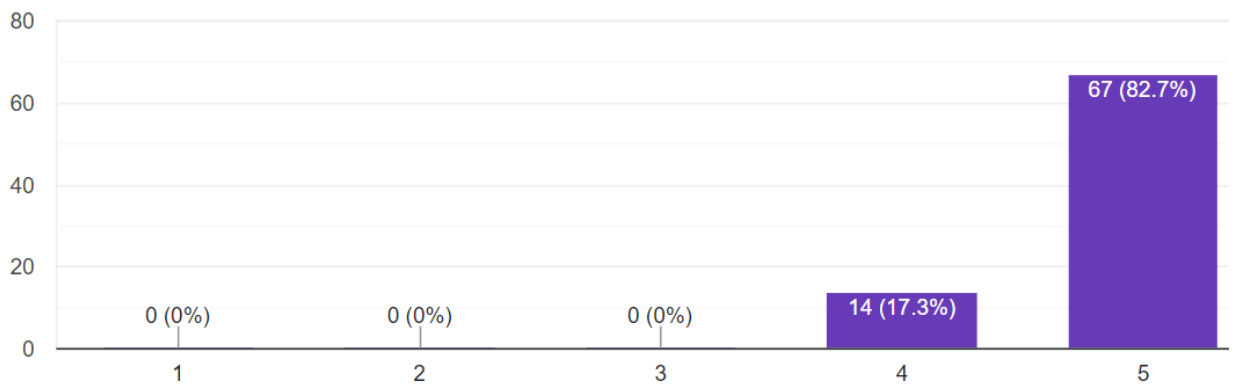
Did the FDP achieve the program objectives ?

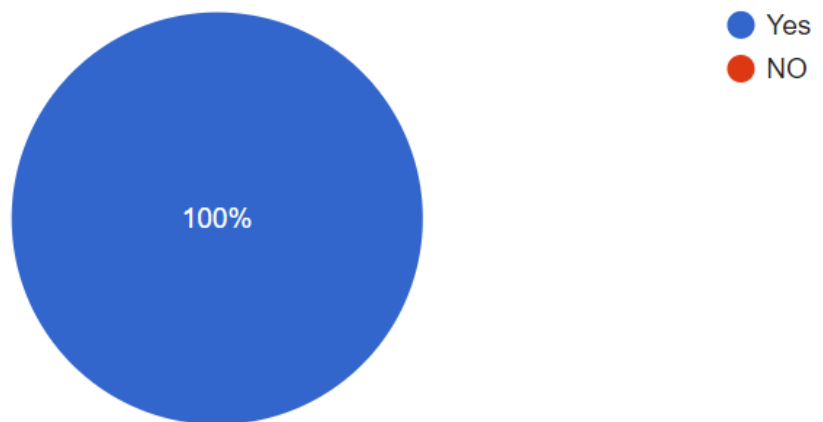

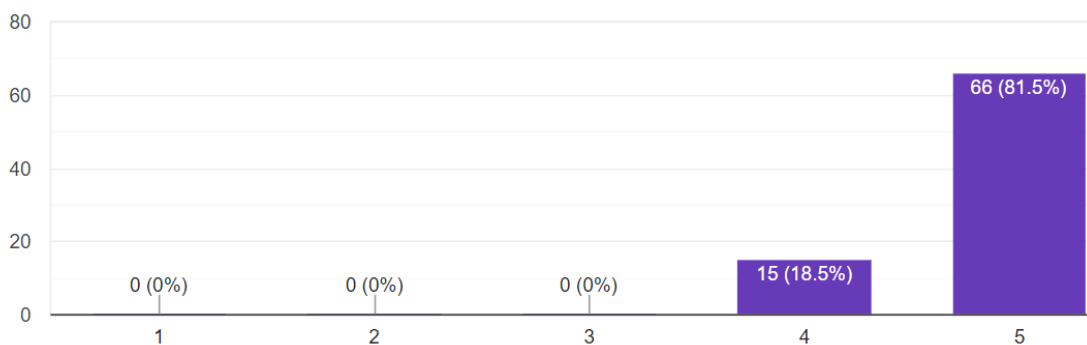

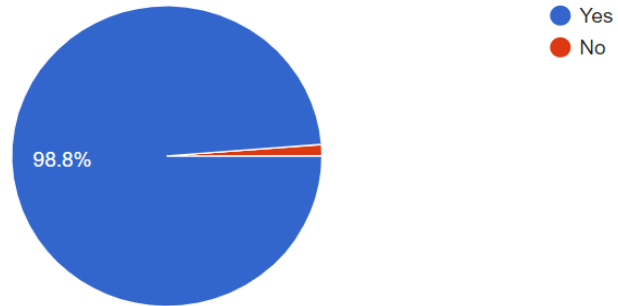
What is overall assessment of the program ?

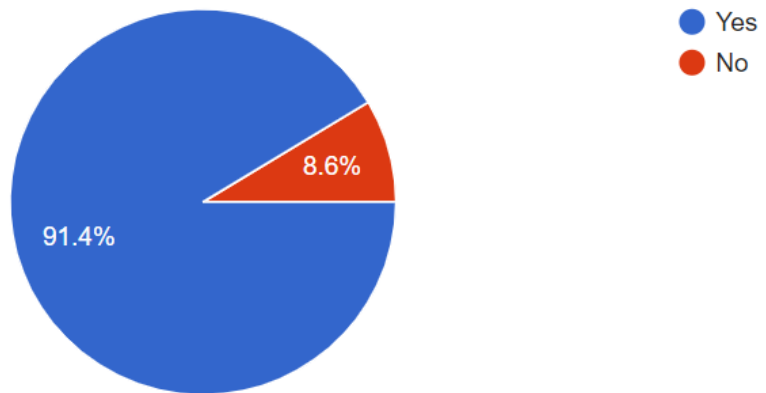

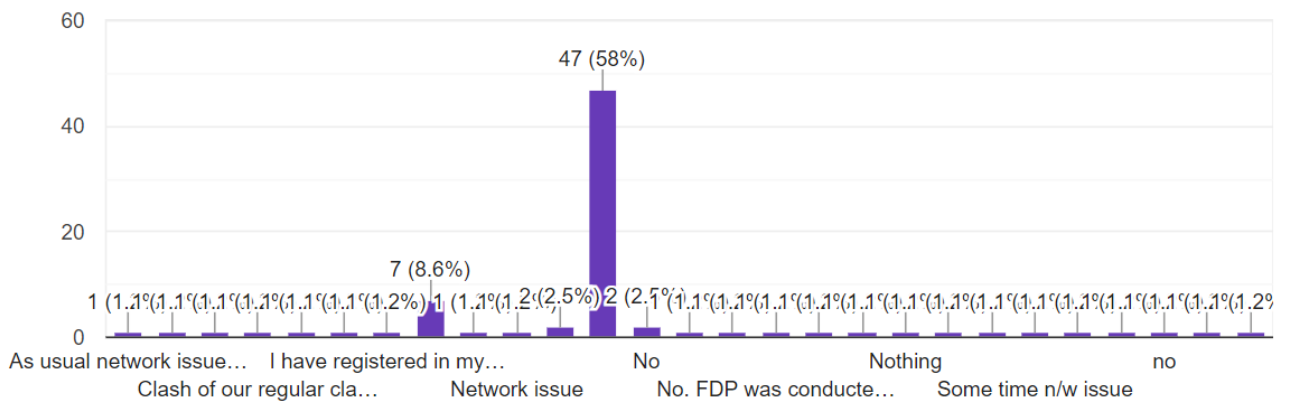
