OBSERVATIONS


Regular internal audit was carried out by identified faculty members of this institution and observations were found satisfactory.

Following are the specific suggestions given to very few individual faculty members of different departments:

1. Use of standard format for cover sheet and index sheet of the course file is to be followed.
2. 100% Completeness of course file is necessary.: Attendance, Marks entry, Result analysis, Attainment of outcomes and associated action plan etc...
3. Internal reviewer (Dept.) must put their signature in the course file as a proof of work completion.
4. Emphasis on innovative teaching practices and higher level of Bloom's taxonomy is necessary while designing QP and CTA assignments.
5. Course plan needs focus in terms of quality of assignments and beyond syllabus / Innovative practices.
6. Course file must have all relevant documents associated with courses taught by a course teacher. Ex: sample CTA assignment submission by a student, attainment of outcomes and action plan etc....
7. Few faculty members have not participated in the review process.

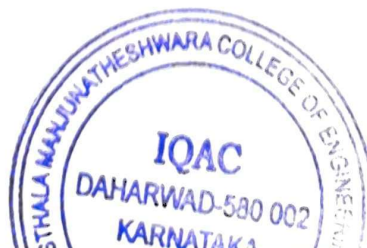
