Policy Statement and Guidelines Regarding Services for Person with disabilities

SDMCET is committed to provide equal opportunity in accessing the benefits, rights & privileges college services, programs and activities to each qualified person with diasibility. All attempts will be made to provide these in compliance with the rights of persons with disabilities Act 2016.

Rights and Responsibilities of persons with Disabilities

Persons with Disabilities at SDMCET have the right to:

- Equal access to programs, activities and services of the College
- Reasonable accommodations, academic adjustments, and/or auxiliary aids and services;
- Appropriate confidentiality of all information concerning their disability except as disclosures are required or permitted by law;
- Life with dignity and respect;
- Protection against discrimination on the ground of disability;
- Protection from all forms of abuse, violence and exploitation

Persons with Disabilities at SDMCET have the responsibility to:

- Meet the qualification requirements as per college norms and maintain essential academic and institutional standards;
- Inform the college when a known disability makes an accommodation necessary to perform successfully in a particular course or program
- Provide appropriate document that indicates how the disability limits participation in programs, activities and services of the College;
- Follow suitable procedure for obtaining reasonable accommodation academic adjustments, and or auxiliary aids and services

SDMCET will try to ensure that all existing structures as well as future construction projects in the campus will consider the needs of the disabled person. SDMCET shall create wherever possible, special facilities such as ramps, rails and special toilets, and make other necessary changes to suit the special needs of persons with disabilities.
